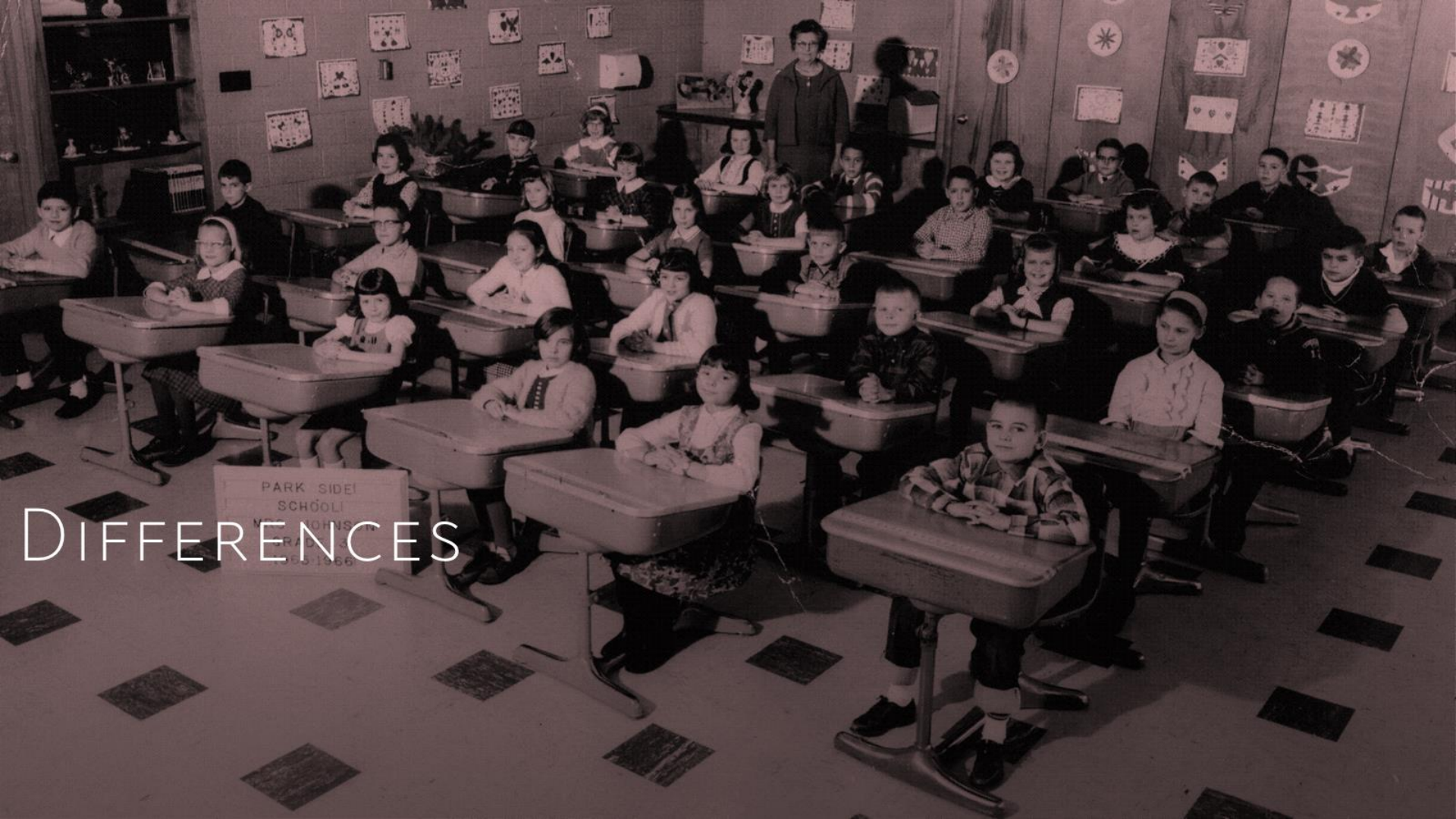

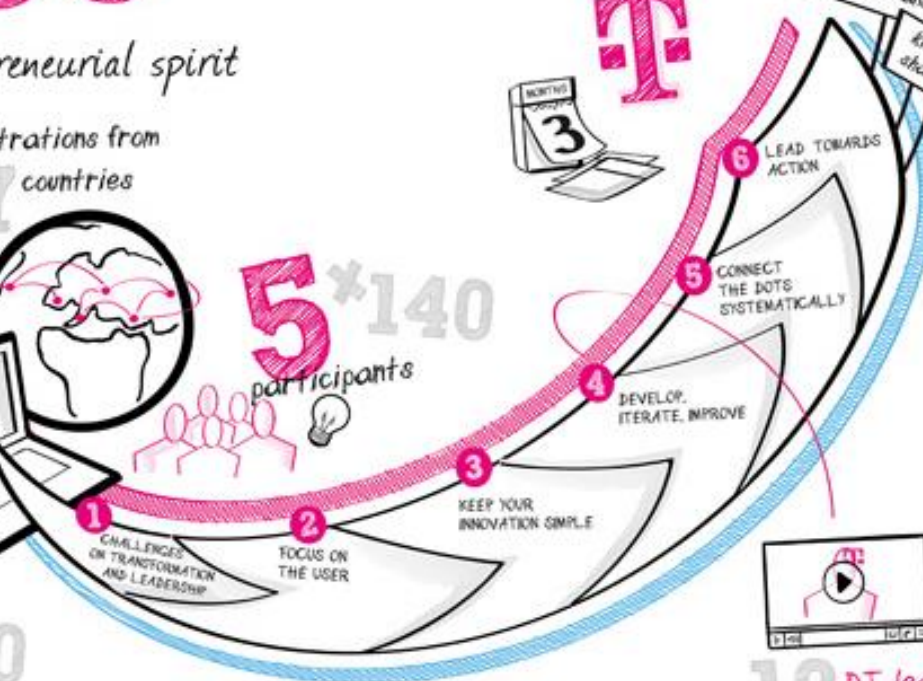

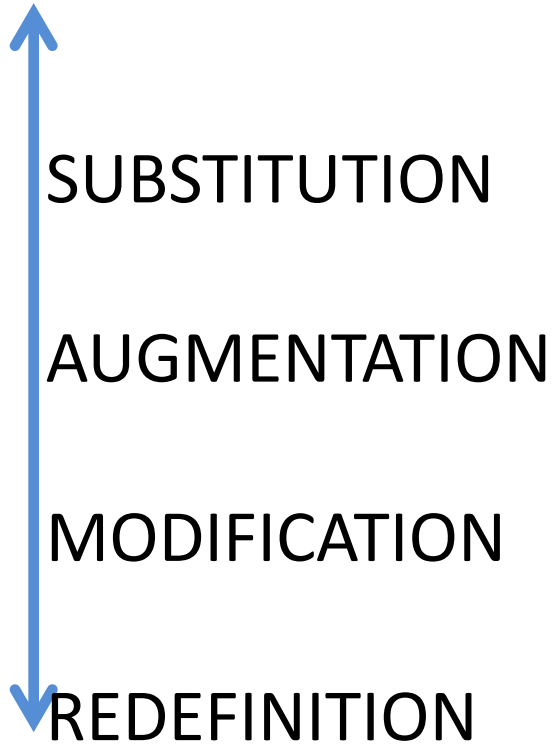


The Technologies Impact Review has confirmed that there is much good practice in technologies around Scotland's centres and schools.
